Hay fever – an allergic reaction disease of the mucous membranes of nose and upper air passages induced by external irritation. Signs and symptoms include: inflammation, watery discharge from the eyes and nose, headaches and asthmatic symptoms.

Why do allergies occur? Sometimes we are born with allergies and sometimes they develop later in life. There is some thought that we are born with the predisposition to allergies especially if it runs in the family and that they are triggered either at birth or later.

Some of the triggers may be virus, bacteria, toxin overload or stress. Once the body is unable to perform at optimal levels we may develop allergies or sensitivities later.



Western treatment: consists of removing the allergen or using suppressive drugs containing nor epinephrine and antihistamines.

Eastern treatment: I began treating allergies with TCM 12 years ago and had moderate success. Since incorporating Neurolink (www.neurolinkglobal.com) last year my success with treating hay fever has been outstanding.

The premise of Neurolink is that the brain has the capacity to heal the body. When the brain or neural system is overloaded it loses its capacity to stay on top of all the functions of the body. The brain will then choose the most severe imbalance or the one that poses the greater health risk and put energy towards that, leaving the other functions to flounder.
